ABEVA'S Annual Meeting and Election of Board Members

Mark your calendars! The annual meeting of ABEVA members will be held Thursday, February 16th, 2017 at 6:30 p.m. in the Grand Canyon Room at the Arizona Biltmore Resort & Spa. Although that may sound far away, it really is not. The function of ABEVA is to govern common areas and address issues that affect the community as a whole. This year, there are four seats up for a vote. Each Director must meet the following criteria:

- 1.) He or she must be a member in good standing of ABEVA.
- 2.) A candidate must be the owner of record of an ABEVA property.

Board meetings are held on the third Monday of each month at 5:30 p.m. in the ABEVA office.

Meetings require a commitment of at least two hours at each meeting plus possible additional time to serve on committees.

If you are considering running for the Board, we ask that you take a few moments to ask yourself the following three questions:

Do I have the time?

As a Board member, you will need to devote several hours of your time each month to association business. In addition to regular monthly Board meetings, you will need to be active in email discussions and occasional special meetings. During special projects, you may need to spend a little extra time on association business. Some board members may also spend a little more time than others if they work with a committee.

Can I make tough decisions when it's required?

The primary role of the board is to conduct the business of the association. This doesn't just mean approving the budget, but also developing and enforcing policies. Board members are required to step outside their immediate circles of family and neighbors and make decisions based on the greater good of the community.

Can I represent ABEVA in and to the larger community?

Our community is only as good as we make it. Therefore, it is important for Board members to attend social functions such as picnics and open houses in

order to foster ABEVA's connection with our homeowners and with our neighbors. If you are interested in running for a seat on the ABEVA board, please submit a biography of 200 words or less that will be sent out with the ballots. You may mail it to the office or email it to cjones@abeva.com. Be sure to include your full name, address, phone number and email with any correspondence. Biographies must be received in the ABEVA office no later than Friday, December 16th at 12:00 noon. Should you have any further questions, you may contact Carol Jones at 602-955-1003. ❖

Annual Assessments for ABEVA

ABEVA is the master association and has an ANNUAL assessment this fiscal year of \$275. Any payment received after November 30th is considered late and will be charged a late fee of \$27.50. Late fees will not be waived. It is the homeowner's responsibility to pay his or her assessment in a timely manner.

There is no requirement that an invoice be sent to ABEVA members. (Article III of the ABEVA CC&Rs). ABEVA sends these as a courtesy and reminder to homeowners; ABEVA cannot be held liable for mail delivery. If you have not paid your annual assessment, please contact the ABEVA office at 602-955-1003. ❖

Summary of ABEVA Collection Policy

1. Assessment (First Notice) mailed out by October 1st, Assessment payment is considered late if postmarked after November 30th.
2. Late fees of 10% (\$27.50) applied 1st workday in December.
3. Late (Second Notice) sent second week in December.
4. Demand (Third Notice) sent 1st week of February.
5. Account sent to attorney if no payment or arrangements are made by 1st week in March.
6. Letter sent from attorney; additional \$250.
7. Property is liened after 10 days; additional \$250.
8. Judgment is pursued, secured and recorded; additional \$650 to \$750.
9. Attempt is made to collect on judgment. ❖
