The next ABEVA Board Meeting is scheduled for Monday, June 16th, 2014 at 5:30 p.m. in the ABEVA office.

Highlights From the May 19th, 2014 ABEVA Board of Directors Meeting

- Banking Carol, Executive Director, presented the Board with the recommendation that ABEVA switch to Phoenix Metro Bank. A motion was made and passed to move all of ABEVA's funds to Phoenix Metro Bank. Phoenix Metro is a state chartered bank that specializes in handling HOA accounts.
- Architectural/Landscape Committee Report George King updated the Board on the improvements being made at Claremont and 32nd St. by Biltmore Greens III. George then reported that he would recommend Martin Umberger to draft plans for the entrance enhancements at 32nd Street & Claremont and Arizona Biltmore Circle & Lincoln. The total cost of the project will likely be \$40k - \$50k.
- **Website** A motion was made and passed that ABEVA will be upgrading the website with a new look. This will produce a significant annual savings.
- Grand Paseo A motion was made to send a letter to Biltmore Mountain Estates and Hillside Villas stating that ABEVA has been notified of the HOAs' intent concerning access to the Grand Paseo

Dogs at Large ∼ By Officer Ben Carro

We have been fielding complaints from the community about dogs off leash at city parks, on the canals, on the streets, etc. Fido is required to be on a leash at all times unless in designated areas such as dog parks. Please review the following laws pertaining to dogs at large.

City Code 8-14 Dogs not permitted at large; wearing licenses.

A. No dog shall be permitted at large. Each dog shall be confined within an enclosure on the owner's or custodian's property, secured so that the dog is confined entirely to the owner's or custodian's property, or on a leash not to exceed six feet in length and directly under the owner's or custodian's control when not on the owner's or custodian's property. The provisions of this subsection shall not apply to a park, or an area within a park, that is designated by the Director or the Parks and Recreation Board as a dog park. Nothing in this section shall prevent the Director or the Parks and Recreation Board from prohibiting dogs or unrestrained dogs in a particular park, preserve or area under its jurisdiction, or any part thereof.

B. Any dog over the age of three months which is off the owner's or custodian's property shall wear a collar or harness to which is attached a valid license tag. Dogs that are used for control of livestock, being used or trained for hunting or dogs, being exhibited or trained at a kennel club event or engaged in races approved by the Arizona Racing Commission, and while the dogs are be-ing transported to and from such events, need not wear a collar or harness with a valid license attached provided that they are properly vaccinated, licensed and controlled.

C. Any owner, custodian, or other person acting for the owner allowing his or her dog to be at large is in violation of this Section.


