Update from the August Board Meeting

- The ABEVA Budget for the fiscal year 2016/2017 was approved at the August Board Meeting. Annual Dues remain \$275 for the 13th consecutive year.
- A new Reserve Study has been completed and was approved by the Board. The report is available in the ABEVA office.
- The ABEVA office is transitioning to new software to serve you better. It will offer different options for payments and better account information access for ABEVA members.

- Golf Course Scalping The over-seeding of the Biltmore golf courses will begin October 3rd for the Adobe Course and will start on October 24th for the Links Course.
- Board of Directors Meeting The next meeting of the ABEVA Board of Directors will be Monday, September 19th at 5:30 p.m. in the ABEVA office.

Arizona Biltmore Street Closures and Restrictions 32nd Street will be CLOSED directly north of Stanford Drive from August 27th, 2016 to September 7th, 2016.

This two-week street closure is required for the City of Phoenix to repair the bridge over the canal at 32nd St. near Stanford Dr. Work will be conducted between 6 a.m. and 7 p.m., seven days a week. Phoenix has partnered with the Town of Paradise Valley to coordinate this important repair. Traffic control devices will be used to guide pedestrians, bicycles and emergency vehicles.

Traffic Restrictions

Northbound 32nd St. traffic will not be able to continue north of Stanford Dr.

Southbound 32nd St. traffic will not be able to continue south of Stanford Dr.

Traffic on westbound Stanford Dr. will not be able to turn right at 32nd St.

This street closure is subject to change based upon prevailing or unexpected conditions.

As part of an ongoing enhancement and maintenance program, the Arizona Biltmore Estates Village Association (ABEVA) is proceeding with pavement repair, concrete repair, crack cleaning and filling, and seal coating of Biltmore Estates Drive and Colter Street. The work will be divided into multiple phases to minimize disruption to residents. Please review the anticipated dates provided below (weather or unforeseeable conditions permitted) and prepare accordingly. Any scheduling modifications (if any) will be provided via the Community Manager, Carol Jones.

August 18-19 saw cut all pavement repairs

September 6-9 crack cleaning and filling
September 12-19 emulsified seal application

September 20 re-stripe and pavement markers

Traffic will be directed around all isolated pavement, concrete repair work and crack filling with minimal impact to accessibility. During the seal coating of Colter isolated street closures will be in place. On Biltmore Estates Drive, block out access will be provided to all residents property, and one way traffic will be provided. Traffic control will be set up during the seal coat operation to provide direction to pedestrians and vehicles. Please obey all traffic control signs and barricades. Your safety and that of the workers is of paramount importance. Please do not drive through barricades onto the fresh seal coat. You will damage your vehicle, and you will be responsible for any repairs to your car and the seal coat.

There will be normal mail delivery and UPS/FedEx deliveries will be permitted during this time with limited accessibility. There will be **No Street Parking** during the entire pavement repair process. Please keep all vehicles off of **ALL streets** and onto your property (including construction and landscape vehicles).





