"Take the Call" or "Make the Call" By Officer Ben Carro



Recently, I have responded to several emails or returned phone calls where the citizen had engaged a subject believed to be suspicious, or in the course of committing an alleged crime.

If the rare circumstance exists that you are a police officer trained in police response and tactics, then by all means make the decision you need to make, rely on your training and "Take the Call."

In all other cases please be a good witness and "MAKE THE CALL!" Crime Stop 602-262-6151 or 911 for an Emergency.

I write this on the heels of a multitude of stories in the past few weeks where I read about or spoke to citizens who took it upon themselves to engage persons believed to be committing a crime or involved in suspicious behavior. Taking this approach is DANGEROUS and can cause significant DELAYS in actual police response.

Before you jump into a situation that could result in a life changing event, consider taking a step back and "Make the Call." Taking this route as opposed to the alternative, and being a good witness will not only ensure a safer environment.



A few things to consider:

- · identify the suspicious behavior or alleged crime
- know your location
- obtain a head to toe description, vehicle description or license plate if possible
- take note of the last known direction of travel

- · provide your reason for the call
- provide your location
- provide your descriptions
- · provide the last known direction of travel

"Ben, I have a camera phone why couldn't I just take a photo?" I only believe in using a camera IF you can do so safely.

from a safe location far enough away from the suspect where you cannot be retaliated against or harmed.

Remember that we are all held accountable for our actions. This could mean criminal charges or civil liability if you make the wrong decision. Prior to "Taking the Call" please error on the side of caution, pick up the phone, "Make the Call" and give trained police officers the opportunity to respond and assist you. Stay safe.
