FROM THE ABEVA OFFICE

Dear Residents,

All of us at the Biltmore have the privilege of living in one of the finest and most exclusive communities in America. There are thousands of people moving to the Valley every week, and the Biltmore remains one of the most sought-after locations in the Greater Phoenix area.

We now find ourselves experiencing inflation rates of 11% or higher with no signs of it easing up in the foreseeable future. ABEVA has seen extensive increases in many of the services we contract for and products we purchase, coupled with material and labor shortages. This affects everything from our landscaping to basic maintenance, and longstanding annual holiday decor.

The news isn't all grim. Your ABEVA board has been working diligently to offset some of these increases through various means of cost reduction. At the beginning of this year, we hired a third-party analyst firm to conduct a time/task study on the ABEVA office in order to more effectively understand and then streamline ABEVA's administration, personnel duties, and the associated costs.

It was found that the ABEVA office was "over-staffed" and had been for years. The work being done at the office on an annual basis, amounts to no more actual work than one capable part-time person can accomplish. Specifically, the workload was calculated at requiring about 54% of a single full-time job; work formerly done by a full-time Director and a part-time administrative assistant. A similar study done in 2014 had similar results, with no action taken by that board at that time. The 2022 BOD, once the position was vacated when the Executive Director resigned, decided to dissolve that unneeded position permanently as of March 2022, freeing up the funds of that salary back into other areas of need. We then promoted our admin Beth Rose to ABEVA Manager, and she is doing a great job at running the office working part-time at 30 hours per week.

(If you wish to review either the 2014 time/task study done of the ABEVA office or the more recent study completed this year, please submit a written request to the ABEVA office and that information will be provided.)

In addition to this significant cost-saving measure, we are also negotiating new contracts with vendors, and by post-poning non-critical items. Most notably, we recently hired a new landscaping firm at a savings of more than \$15K per year.

The 2023 ABEVA budget has been approved, and we are pleased to announce that despite skyrocketing inflation, thanks to the aforementioned cost-saving measures, there will be no need to increase the annual ABEVA dues for next year.

Please know that we are doing our very best to serve the community.

You are always welcome to attend our board meetings on the third Monday of each month. We value your input and ideas. We will do our best to keep you updated.

Beautification Committee Update

The Beautification Committee is hard at work value engineering the renderings completed by Greey Picket, our land-scape architectural partner, and SDL, the retained contractor.

We thank Blackstone and the Hotel for providing ABEVA access to their molds and production facility located on the Hotel grounds. This is where they are making the custom FLW Biltmore Block pieces to renovate the historical block at the Hotel. ABEVA will be pulling block needs from this facility.

I would like to remind our community that we are funding the Beautification and Improvements to our three entrances from our \$1mm excess reserve fund.

We are targeting completion of the ABC & Lincoln and the Colter and 32nd St. entrance by the end of this year. The main entry completion date will follow, slowed by the City of Phoenix permitting process.

We are excited to complete this Beautification and Improvement project and to install the Biltmore Estates street sign that replaces Thunderbird Trail by late November of this year.

We are hoping to release final details and drawings in an article featured in the October issue of *Biltmore Lifestyles* and *Stroll Biltmore* magazines.

Adobe Course and Driving Range will be Closed Temporarily in August and September: As part of a multi-phase improvement project, the Arizona Biltmore Golf Club has temporarily closed its Adobe Golf Course and driving range throughout the months of August and September to begin prep work for a summer 2023 course renovation led by the Lehman Design Group. The Adobe Course will reopen for play this October following overseeding. The Links Golf Course will remain open for play in August and September, as will the golf shop and Adobe Restaurant and Bar. To assist with parking on busy days, the Arizona Biltmore Golf Club will continue to provide complimentary valet service.

Clubhouse Renovations Update: With concrete and form work complete on the basement, crews are now working on the early stages of the walls that will frame the new golf shop and cart storage area. Progress continues on schedule as construction teams work through the summer monsoon heat and humidity. With so many neighbors out of town during the hot summer months, crews have added Saturdays to their work schedule.
