BIG CHANGES ARE COMING!

ABEVA is planning landmark renovations, the most extensive in its history. Costs are projected to be \$1 million for the beautification of our Community, the Arizona Biltmore Estates.

Last November, the Board created the ABEVA Beautification Committee with Bill McKay as Chairman, and the members include Will Hawkins, Wes Balmer, Keith Mishkin, Garnett Harding, and John Lynch. The Board authorized a non-binding working budget of \$500,000 to \$1 million.

The Committee's charge is to create more of a unified image branding for the Community and to define the entry experiences to include landscaping, decorative walls, gateways, lighting, and signage. The Committee solicited seven Requests for Proposal, it received five answers, and the Board accepted Greedy Pickett as the Architect Designer. Thus far, the Committee's primary focus has been on the four entrances: 24th St. and Thunderbird Trail; 24th St. and Arizona Biltmore Circle; Lincoln and Arizona Biltmore Circle; and, 32nd St. and Colter. The Committee has discussed expanding its focus and scope.

The Committee is working with a rough budget of approximately \$500,000 to \$1 million, which thus far includes: \$350,000 for the main entrance at 24th St. and Thunderbird Trail; \$150,000 for 24th St. and Arizona Biltmore Circle; \$100,000 for Arizona Biltmore Circle and Lincoln; \$40,000 for 32nd St. and Colter; and \$15,000 for preliminary architectural plans. The Committee is working on a proposal to the Board regarding the overall funding of this project; among other things, increase the annual dues, special assessments, bank loan financing, and third party "sponsorship funding."

Landscape

Lawn Watering: If you're watering every day, then you're watering too much!

The following watering recommendations are based on science from the University of Arizona. It is healthier for grass if you apply .75 inch (3/4 inch) of water each time you irrigate to wet the root zone to a depth of about 8 inches. This encourages roots to go deeper into the soil where they are better protected from hot, dry winds. With this amount of water, your grass will only need watering once every three days in the hottest part of summer, and less often as we get into the fall months. If you are watering on a slope, it is better to water for shorter time periods more often giving the water a chance to soak in rather than run off into the street. Please watch your watering during the rainy season. Also, adjust your sprinklers so they are not watering the sidewalk and street. ABEVA Patrol will mark irrigation leaks with a pink flag, and you may get a phone call or email notification. ❖


Doggy Etiquette

Please be considerate of your neighbors and don't let your dog bark continuously. In Phoenix, it is a Class 1 Misdemeanor for any person to keep a dog that is in the habit of barking or howling or disturbs the peace and quiet of another person (*Phoenix Barking Dog Ordinance*). If you have been informed your dog is disturbing another person's peace, you need to take action.

Before you report your neighbor, try talking to them or leave them a note; be friendly, not angry. Document the date and time the dog is barking, and if you can, get a video or picture of the dog barking. Mediation will be required before a criminal complaint will be considered. You can get help at: <https://www.phoenix.gov/law/prosecutor/barking-dogs>.

While we're addressing etiquette, let's talk about picking up after your dog. They can't do it; they don't have thumbs. Please don't embarrass your dog by leaving their poo for someone to step in or spread disease. Tie a bag around your leash and you're ready to clean up after your best friend.

Please remember to walk your puppies early in the morning. Pavement temperatures can reach 150 degrees by mid-day. If you need to wear shoes, your dog does too! ❖
