2019 Annual ABEVA Meeting Report

The Annual Meeting of the Arizona Biltmore Estates Village Association (ABEVA) was held at the Arizona Biltmore Resort in the Gold Room and was attended by approximately 150 ABEVA members.

The following ABEVA members were elected to the Board for two-year terms: Jim Bell, Will Hawking and Judith Shafkind. Congratulations to the incumbents and thank you to Camille and Andrew for your interest in serving on the Board of Directors. The officers elected February 18th are James Bell – President; Steve Helm – Vice President/ Secretary; and Judith Shafkind – Treasurer.

The guest speaker, Sheila Foley, was delayed at the airport and unable to attend the meeting.

State of the Association – Jim Bell reported on the 2018 accomplishments.

PUD Rezoning - The Board has hired a zoning attorney and a team of professionals to consult on the proposed PUD rezoning project at 24th Street and Arizona Biltmore Circle. The review is in preliminary stages. The goal is to help protect the community and the individual owner's property values.

Resort PUD - ABEVA is working to gain compliance from the Resort with regards to parking rules laid out in the Resort PUD Restrictions.

Grand Paseo - A reply from the City of Phoenix is pending regarding the gate at Lincoln tunnel. The community to the north has blocked access to the Grand Paseo trail, which creates a safety issue in the tunnel.

Street Lights - Street lights have been replaced with LED bulbs which has decreased the cost of maintenance from \$6,500.00 annually to \$650.00.

Seal Coating - Seal coating will be done this year on Arizona Biltmore Circle between Lincoln and 24th Street.

Sidewalks - Sidewalks have been inspected and repaired to avoid any trip hazards.

Security - One of the major amenities of homeownership at the Biltmore is the reassuring presence of the Roving Patrol. ABEVA has contracted with Transcend Security Solutions to provide 24 hour, 7 day a week patrol service throughout all ABEVA sub associations and common areas. There are 3 weekday officers and 2 weekend officers.

There has been improvement not only in the patrol service, but also financially, with reduced administrative costs and substantial savings by switching to electric patrol vehicles. A charging station was installed in the parking lot at the ABEVA office, which is saving over \$500 a month in gasoline costs and is reducing the carbon footprint of the association.

The Roving Patrol drives 16 miles of road each tour - every 8 hours 3 tours are completed, thus 9 tours of the entire Biltmore property take place every day. If you do the math, that is 52,560 miles a year, and they drive over 639 speed bumps per day.

The annual recap sheet is posted on the website and there are monthly reports in *The BRIEF* so you can review the types of incidents they respond to every day. Most will agree, we have an outstanding team of roving patrol guards portraying both responsibility and courtesy. Should you need Roving Patrol phone stickers, you may stop by the ABEVA office to pick them up.

Title Transfers - There were 145 ABEVA homes that changed ownership this past year vs. 175 in 2017 vs. 147 in 2016. The 145 closings generated \$55,000 in Transfer and Disclosure fees. If you are selling your home, please remember that you must disclose that you are a member of at least two associations – ABEVA and your sub association(s).

Treasurers Report - The financials were provided to the owners present in the meeting packet. Ms. Shafkind reported that the budget is healthy, and the bad debt ratio is less than 2%. The 2018 financials were reviewed by the CPA in January, and a report is available at the ABEVA office.

Collections - As of this date, there are 15 (vs. 20 on this date last year) homeowners that have not paid their dues. They have been sent invoices, late letters and demand letters, and calls and emails have been made. We make every effort to collect on these balances before sending them to the attorney for collections. If payment is not received by March 1st, the delinquent accounts will be sent to the attorney's office for collection and they will incur additional legal fees of approximately \$500.
