### Road Repairs


The seal coating will begin on Biltmore Estates Drive Monday, May 11th. They will be seal coating the outside of the road around the circle the 11th and 12th, then the inside the 13th and 14th. Colter will be seal coated the 15th and 16th. Notification letters are being sent out to all residents on the circle and the Community Managers of the sub associations. Seal coating will begin at 7:00 a.m. The sections that are scheduled will be closed for 12 hours, and traffic will be one way only. You will have access to your driveway. Please do not go around barricades, not only will you damage the street, you will cause damage to your car, and you will be charged for any required repairs to ABEVA property.

It is imperative that all landscaping sprinklers and irrigation systems in the front yard are turned off all day during the scheduled seal coating application between May 11th and the 16th. Please see map below for schedule.

# **Arizona Biltmore Golf Club News**

Following is a letter that was written to Councilman Sal DiCiccio regarding the Arizona Biltmore Golf Club that he would like to share with you:

Dear Mr. DiCiccio:

It was a pleasure to meet you today at the beautiful Biltmore Golf Course. Thank you for taking the time to make Phoenix a safer place.

I have been a medical doctor for decades, and I spent over 20 years at St. Joseph's as Chairman of the Emergency Department. Additionally, it was my honor to serve as the President of the Maricopa County Heart Association and the Chief Medical Physician for the Arizona Boxing Commission.

I want to applaud the efforts JDM has taken to make the golf experience at the Biltmore Golf Club as safe as reasonably possible. The protocol I observed and the list I was provided include the following:

- Eliminated every other tee-time effectively reducing traffic by 50% and doubling spacing between golfers
- · Nightly sanitizing the entire shop and restrooms from cleaning crew every night
- · Carts/coolers/steering wheels/seats are sanitized after every use
- · All sand bottles have been removed, and GPS screens are being sanitized after each use
- Tees and pencils are only on the carts (no community bowls of tees, pencils and towels)
- · Doors, counter tops, and credit card machines all sanitized after every use
- · Doors propped open during business hours
- On-course restrooms are cleaned 3 times a day
- On-course credit card machines, beverage car/hands counters cleaned/sanitized after each use, and gloves are available for all employees
- · Online payments and pre-payments are being encouraged
- · Customers are limited to one group checking in at a time
- Other groups waiting to check-in wait outside
- Guests who have pre-paid or have card on file can check-in outside
- · No cash accepted
- Guests are carrying their own clubs and loading carts staff there to direct
- · Range baskets are being sanitized after every use
- Every staff member has bottles of sanitizer in their work area
- Ball washers are wrapped and not usable
- On-Course water coolers have been removed
- · Carts are allowed in parking lot, and guests are removing their own trash from carts
- Individual cart usage and walking is being allowed
- Raised cups 1.5 inches above ground, and rakes have been removed from bunkers
- · Bag stands have been removed from range
- Flags have been removed from all practice areas
- · Not cleaning clubs unless specifically requested by guest
- · All rental clubs are sanitized after use

I would add to the extensive list above that any guest who is found not in compliance with the above or exhibits physical symptoms of COVID-19 (coughing, hacking, shortness of breath) will be asked by staff to unconditionally and immediately leave the premises. I also have been told that the Biltmore Golf Course is now, regardless of family status, limiting the use of the golf carts to a single person.

Certainly, transmission of COVID-19 or any contagion is still possible even with the stringent protocol currently in place at the Biltmore Golf Course. However, I believe the benefits of exercise, fresh air, sunshine and moderate socialization the golfers enjoy are worth the minimal risk of transmission.

I see no significant issue with leaving golf courses open provided they post and enforce the above indicated "JDM" protocol. Certainly, some modest oversight and enforcement of the JDM protocol should be done by city of Phoenix staff, with clubs both private and public, found to be in violation of the above are fined or lose their right to remain open.

I wish you well and the best of health in these difficult times and thank you for all you do for the City of Phoenix and your constituents.
