A Note from SRP **Be Aware of Payment Scams**

Please remember that scammers will:

- Pretend to be from SRP. If you receive a call from someone who says they are from SRP, HANG UP and call SRP directly at 602-236-8888, even if your caller ID says it's SRP calling.
- Threaten immediate power disconnection. They'll threaten to turn off power unless a payment is made generally in an hour. SRP will always send you one or more notices by mail and, if you are enrolled in SRP eNotes™, by email.
- Demand payment. SRP will never request that you use a particular payment method. SRP will never demand immediate payments, threaten same-day disconnection or accept payment via prepaid cash cards or Zelle over the phone or in person.

SRP does not accept payments from Zelle.

To protect yourself, download the free SRP app for up-todate account information. If you suspect a call is a scam, hang up and call SRP at 602-236-8888. Learn more tips to keep you safe at srp.net/scam.

Arizona Biltmore Golf Club News

Here are a few of the things happening at the Arizona Biltmore Golf Club and The Adobe Restaurant throughout September.

Adobe Course and Driving Range will be Closed Temporarily in September: As part of a multi-phase improvement project, the Arizona Biltmore Golf Club has temporarily closed its Adobe Golf Course and driving range throughout the months of August and September to begin prep work for a summer 2023 course renovation led by the Lehman Design Group. The Adobe Course will reopen for play this October 24th following overseeding. The Links Golf Course will remain open for play in September, as will the golf shop and Adobe Restaurant. To assist with parking on busy days, the Arizona Biltmore Golf Club will continue to provide complimentary valet service.

Golf Course Overseeding Dates: The Adobe Course will be cart path only through Halloween day. The Links Course will then be closed for overseeding October 24th through November 13th. The Links Course will reopen November 14th and will be cart path only for one week after reopening.

Clubhouse Renovations Update: Construction continues on schedule of the new golf shop and golf cart storage building. In August, crews completed the basement where carts will be stored and the floor of the golf shop. The building's exterior walls will go up quickly in September. Phase one of the renovation project is expected to be completed in early 2023 and will include a new golf shop and member facilities (located in one building) and underground cart storage.
