#### Highlights from the January 18th, 2015 ABEVA Board of Directors Meeting

Late Fees - Second notices were sent out the second week in December if a homeowner's assessment was not paid. The 3rd and Final Notice will be sent out the second week of February if the assessment is still outstanding. Delinquent accounts will be sent to the ABEVA attorney for collection if payment is not received or arrangements are not made by March 10th. Please contact our office to avoid legal fees.

#### **Speeding Within the Biltmore Estates**

Within the City of Phoenix, there are three speed limits that are known as absolute speed limits. In these zones you can be ticketed for 1 MPH over the speed limit without regard for mitigating conditions. These are: school zones, 25 MPH residential zones, and 55 MPH highway zones. All other speed limits set by the city, are based on the reasonable flow of traffic, identified by speed surveys. The ABEVA speed limit is posted 20 or 25 MPH on all streets. Some of the reasons for the 25 MPH speed limit include driver response time and injury related to speed. It typically takes a driver 1.6 seconds to initiate braking action, AFTER they have observed a need to stop. At 25 MPH this works out to 58 feet which leaves about 25-30 feet, for overall distance to stop of 80

feet. Please have consideration for ABEVA residents and pedestrians, be mindful of your driving habits and take a little more care in daily routines; slow down, no texting and keep your eyes on the road so we can all be a little safer.

#### Happy Valentine's Day!

Valentine's Day, also known as Saint Valentine's Day or the Feast of Saint Valentine, is a celebration observed on February 14th each year. It is celebrated in many countries around the world. Here are some fun things to do in the Phoenix area:

- Plan to be at Fountain Park in Fountain Hills on Valentine's Day, February 14th, 2016, to renew your vows or witness what might be the largest vow renewal ceremony in the world. Hundreds of couples participate. Married couples wishing to renew their vows must register.
- A festival of chocolate in downtown Glendale features not only a celebration of chocolate, but also romance. Gourmet cuisine and beverages, horse-drawn carriage rides, entertainment and tours of Cerreta Candy Company. In 2016, it happens February 5th through the 7th. More than 35 chocolate specialty vendors offer everything from chocolate chipotle popcorn, chocolate crepes and chocolate caramel potato chips.
