



Electronic Voting for the ABEVA Board of Directors

Prior to the annual meeting, the homeowners vote for members of the ABEVA Board of Directors. Previously, voting has been done by paper ballot, however this year it will be by electronic voting. There will also be the ability to request a paper ballot



This is a safe and efficient method to increase participation, while saving both time and money.

At the beginning of January, an email will be sent to each homeowner, to the email address ABEVA has on file, from Election Buddy (electionbuddy.com). The email link will redirect you to Election Buddy's website to vote.

If you do not have an email address or prefer to vote by mail, a paper ballot may be requested from the ABEVA office by calling 602-955-1003.





ABEVA Board of Directors Election

This year, there are **four** seats to be filled on the ABEVA Board of Directors. If you are interested in running for a seat on the Board, please submit a biography of 200 words or less that will be sent out with the ballots. Please email your biography to abevaoffice@abeva.com. Be sure to include your full name, address, phone number, and email with any correspondence. Biographies must be received in the ABEVA office **no later than Wednesday, December 14th at noon**. Should you have any further questions, you may contact the ABEVA office at 602-955-1003.

Each Director must meet the following criteria:

1.) Must be a member in good standing of ABEVA.

2.) Must be the owner of record of an ABEVA property.

Board meetings are held on the third Monday of each month at 5:30 p.m. in the ABEVA office.

Meetings require a commitment of at least two hours at each of the meetings, plus possible additional time to serve on committees.

If you are considering running for the board, take a few moments to ask yourself the following questions:

Do I have the time?

As a board member, you will need to devote a couple of hours of your time each month to association business. Some board members may also spend a little more time than others if they work on a committee.

Can I make tough decisions when it's required?

The board's primary role is to conduct the association's business. This means, among many tasks, approving the budget, developing and enforcing policies, engaging contractors, and dealing with oversight of the ABEVA office.

ABEVA Annual Assessments Now Past Due

ABEVA is the master association and has an Annual Assessment of \$325. If you have not paid your Annual Assessment, it is considered late and a late fee of \$32.50 will be charged. Late fees will not be waived. It is the homeowner's responsibility to pay the assessment promptly. There is no requirement that an invoice is sent to ABEVA members. (Article III of the ABEVA CC&Rs). If you have not paid your annual assessment, please contact the ABEVA office to make payment arrangements.

ABEVA Assessment Collection Policy

The complete collection policy is available at ABEVA.com under "Governance; Governing Documents."

The following is a summary of the fees:

- 1. Assessment (First Notice) mailed out by October 1st, Assessment payment is considered late if postmarked after November 30th.
- 2. Late fee of 10% (\$32.50) was applied on December 1st.
- 3. First Delinguency Notice sent on or about the second week in December; \$20 collection fee applied to the ledger.
- 4. Second Delinguency Notice sent on or about 1st week of January; \$100 collection fee applied to the ledger.
- 5. Third Delinguency Notice sent on or about 2nd week of February, a \$100 collection fee will be applied to the ledger.
- 6. If an account remains delinguent by the 2nd week in March, a lien will be filed; a \$300 lien fee will be applied to the ledger.
- 7. At any time in this process, the account may be turned over to the Association's legal counsel for collection actions.
