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


# FROM THE ABEVA OFFICE Beautification Update

The Beautification Committee continues its work on the comprehensive renovation of the common areas. This includes a plan to resurface, stripe, and mark the road system after completion of the City's Water Project next July. In the meantime, a lot is happening behind the scenes. All monument signs featuring FLW block bases and illuminated boxes will be replaced (rendering pictured of the "Privacy" sign).



The Waldorf Astoria "Hotel" sign near the gate to Taliverde and Colony Biltmore Greens will also be replaced with a monument base and illuminated box sign. Demolition and construction at the Lincoln and ABC and 32nd St. and Colter entrances should be completed by early December or thereabouts and the 24th St. and Biltmore Estates entrance by the end of January. The first guardhouse will receive a facelift along with art deco Frank Lloyd Wright stained glass film applied to the new windows, a theme derived from the stained glass exhibit inside the front entrance of the hotel.

The Biltmore Golf Club renovation and clubhouse completion will cap off a reimagined Biltmore Estates Community. We are grateful for the work the Colony Biltmore Greens Community has undertaken to renovate its frontage along 24th Street. The Beautification Committee will now be focusing on the center island architectural design work at the 24th and Biltmore Estates entrance.

Final grading is complete, all holes have been sprigged with Bermuda grass, and landscape work continues as new trees are being planted. In October, the golf

course will be overseeded with rye grass as we prepare for an early November opening. It's exciting to see the new Tom Lehman-design spring to life!

New Clubhouse Construction Update: Work continues on the magnificent new Arizona Biltmore Golf Club clubhouse. Exterior walls have been framed, work has begun on the roof, and work on interior walls has started. The clubhouse project is expected to be completed in 2024.
