COP Biltmore Estates Water **Project Update**

The City of Phoenix's extensive efforts to replace water lines along Biltmore Estates Circle roadways are set to persist until the latter part of 2024. Despite inconveniences caused by road disrepair during the project, assurances have been given by the city to the ABEVA board that the road surface will be fully restored upon project completion. This undertaking underscores the municipality's commitment to modernizing infrastructure while mitigating disruptions to residents and businesses.

Beautification Update

The Beatification Project is about to commence into full construction. City permits are about to be pulled for 24th street entry with a couple weeks to process a traffic safety permit for the removal of the tall eucalyptus trees, that can now be processed with the Site Permit approval completion.

The Biltmore blocks with the perforations for light illumination were received. This will allow completing the Coulter and ABC block work with landscaping to follow.

Now that the 24th Street permits are ready and the block is at the contractor's yard, we will see things moving much more expediently than in the last few months.
